

Machu Picchu Experience (4 days)

This itinerary allows you to visit Cusco, the colonial and Inka capital city, unique in South America. At the same time, acclimatize to avoid altitude problems later and continue with your planned itinerary, such as the Sacred Valley of the Incas, which is one of the most beautiful tours. Thanks to the constructions made by our Inca ancestors, this visit also allows us to visit and learn about towns and traditional customs that have been preserved for hundreds of years.

After this beautiful experience we headed to the train station in the afternoon, which will take us to the town of Aguascalientes where we will have a pleasant rest before heading to the next day very early towards the wonder of Machu Picchu where we will have the opportunity to see the sunrise of the Sun God.

Later after having a guided tour inside the citadel built by the Incas, we will take the return bus that will take us to the town of Aguascalientes where we take the train back to the city of Cusco.

The next day you will also have the option to visit Rainbow Mountain, which is revolutionizing the world due to the natural colors that the mountain offers us.

After the itinerary you will see that the time invested was satisfactory.

DESCRIPTION OF THE ITINERARY.

Day 1:

Pick up from the airport and transfer to the hotel in the city of Cusco.

City tour - This tour will allow us to walk through the city of this colonial and Inca city, visiting the local market.

Sacsayhuaman - Constructions with stones weighing more than 100 tons, carved and stacked to perfection.

Qenqo - still existing room that was used as a place of Inca mummification and human sacrifice.

Puka pucara - Fortress for the control and protection of the most important city.

Tambomachay - Fountain of purification and relaxation used by the Inca nobility before heading to their sacred places.

Llama and alpaca farm -

- On this tour, you'll have the opportunity to visit, touch, and take photos of llamas and alpacas, while also sharing the experience of ancestral weaving.

- After the tour, you will be transferred back to your hotel for rest and recovery before the next day's tour.

- The city tour ends around 2:00 p.m.

Day 2:**SACRED VALLEY**

- Pick-up from your hotel for the adventure will be at 8:00 AM, to allow enough time to visit the attractions.
- The first stop will be at the Taray viewpoint, which will give us an idea of the beauty of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Later, after 20 minutes in the vehicle, we will arrive at the archaeological remains of Pisac where we will have a one-hour visit, and then Return to the colonial town of Pisac to visit the artisan shops that work in Peruvian gold and silver.
- After Pisac we head to Urubamba where you will have a delicious lunch, and then continue the trip to the last living village from the time of the Incas. We'll have the opportunity to visit some homes that are still in use. We'll also see the canals where water still flows as it did 700 years ago.
- After the guided tour in the town of Ollantaytambo we headed to the train station that will take us to the town of Aguascalientes where we will rest.
